Class "A" Structural Burn Trailer - 8 hrs.

This hands-on class is a live fire class using Class "A" burn materials. Students will see different fire growth stages, and learn proper ways to attack vented and unvented fires, using correct nozzles patterns, and ways to use hydraulic and positive pressure ventilation. This class will adhere to NFPA 1403.

Training utilizes the NDFA Mobile Burn Trailer. Each session begins with a safety briefing which includes an orientation of the trailer, medical evaluation (pulse and BP for each student), followed by three evolutions under live fire conditions. NDFA requires a minimum of five (5) Instructors to conduct live fire training. training including instructor fee, mileage, hotel, and incidentals. Training will be scheduled based on availability of NDFA mobile training unit and instructors.

Host Responsibilities:



Clean shaven. Clean shaven means no facial hair is present where the seal of the air mask comes into contact with your face. Live Fire Instructors have been instructed to not allow students to participate in live fire classes who do not meet this clean-shaven definition



Students must 18 years or older



Consent to pre and post entry medical evaluation

- 1. Pulse below 100 beats per min.
- 2. Respirations...12-20 breaths per min.
- 3. Temperature...Less than 99.9
- 4. Blood Pressure...Less than 160 systolic and/or 100 diastolic
