

ELIGIBILITY

TEAMS: An eligible fishing team shall be made up of 2 to 4 persons who are signed up for the NDFA Convention. (No licensed ND guides)

FISHING AREAS

Boundaries will be all navigable waters on Devils Lake only. All boats will leave the ramp under a single file controlled start beginning with the boat registered #1.

REGULATIONS

All contestants must observe the US Coast Guard and ND Game & Fish Dept. rules, regulations, laws & license requirements. Life preservers must be worn when the boat is on a plane. All teams are responsible for their fish following the tournament. Contestants are reminded that the "Spirit of the Rule" will prevail in all judgment cases.

REGISTRATION • ENTRIES • WEIGH-IN PRE-REGISTRATION REQUESTS

Teams must register prior to the tournament scheduled time. No late entries will be allowed. Each team will be issued a team number. At the weigh-in, one member of the team must deliver their number to the scoreboard, even if the team does not have any fish to weigh. The team may then load out their boat & proceed to weigh-in their catch.

AQUATIC NUISANCE SPECIES

All watercraft not licensed in this state and operated on North Dakota waters must annually obtain a valid, nonrefundable aquatic nuisance species sticker. This ANS sticker must be placed on the starboard side of the watercraft within 6 inches of the registration number and displayed within 10 days of purchase. Each licensed watercraft is listed on the purchase receipt. A copy of the purchase receipt is proof of validation until the sticker is received via postal mail.

SCORING

Team standings shall be determined by a total weight of their chosen 1 Northern Pike (measured & picture taken), 5 Walleye, and 1 White Bass. The northern pike must be a minimum length of 20 inches and the walleye must be at least 15 inches. The teams can keep their ND limit of walleye white bass and northern pike. Any ties will be determined by the largest walleye. There will be no early weigh-in unless arrangements have been made with tournament directors.

TOURNAMENT PRIZES

Prizes & Cash Payouts: Cash payout to be awarded to the top 3 teams (total weight) based on 90% of the entry fees received using the following formula 1st Place; 50%, 2nd Place; 30%, 3rd Place; 20%. (10% of the entry fee will be donated to the Lake Region Anglers)
Calcutta will be available for \$30 largest (\$10-White Bass, \$10-Walleye, \$10-Northern Pike)
