



Heavy Vehicle Extrication - 8 hrs.



This class is intended for current extrication certified firefighters. The class will consist of classroom and intense hands on. You will be covering several types of heavy trucks and vehicles that we are seeing more of everyday in North Dakota. You will practice everything from scene size-up to patient care. You will learn different ways to stabilize using cribbing, struts, and air bags, extricate working at different heights in relations to everyday cars and trucks, and become familiar with the size and weight differences in the heavy trucks. This class will be 8 hours long, to include classroom and hands-on practical with heavy trucks, trailers and cars.

This class takes some coordination prior to class date due to the size of the vehicles. The instructor will assist with setting up the required assets.

Host Responsibilities

- At least 2 vehicles for minimum 12 students. Additional vehicles may be required depending on number of students.
- Will be responsible for supplying the big vehicles such as: buses, semis, trailers, and such for this class.
- Rehab (cases of water).
- Portable toilet or restroom.
- Minimum of 12 students, if not met, host organization(s) may be held responsible for the cost for the training including instructor fees, mileage, hotel, & incidentals.

Minimum Student Requirements

- Full PPE
- Students must be 18 years of age (minimum) to receive certification.
